Some synonyms for refreshing are invigorating, rejuvenating, restoring, reviving, and stimulating per Merriam Webster.

After a man or woman spends a long day on the job, he or she is in need of a refreshing. When a student sits under an instructor for a period of time, the student needs a break for refreshing. Teachers are life long learners because they need to be refreshed and updated in their field. Congress take breaks from their work because of their need for refreshing. Every person have periods of stress that dictate they are in need of refreshing.

Many pastors and people in the care ministry get so focused on serving and taking care of others that they forget to take care of themselves and are experiencing burnout in record numbers. Barna Research published the results of a research conducted among Protestant pastors that shows the percentage of pastors who have contemplated abandoning their church roles rose from 38% in the fall of 2021 to 42% as of March 2022. Stress is the number one reason sighted for these results. Over 56% of pastors who have considered quitting full-time ministry say “the immense stress of the job” has factored into their thoughts on leaving (Barna).

First, I want to encourage every pastor to take a vacation and refresh yourself on a regular basis. Get away from the busy schedule and communicate with the Most High and the family He has blessed you with.

It is in the times of refreshing that the Lord reveals to His own what His will for us is. He also gives us insight on how to accomplish what seems to be impossible with the smallest amount of stress. We are reminded in times of refreshing that we don't have to have all the answers. It is not for us to do it all. With a relaxed mind we can better hear what ABBA is saying to us concerning the ministry He has called us to.



Prayer...uninterrupted solitary prayer is another way to refresh a stale soul. It is most rewarding to retreat to a quiet environment where there will be no distractions with a Bible, a bottle of water, and an ear to hear what the Lord has to say.
